We would not operate an aircraft if we believed it posed a health or safety risk to our customers or crew.

The cockpit/cabin is the normal place of work of more than 15,000 cabin crew members and over 3,600 pilots employed by British Airways and we see no trends in sickness rates which would indicate a link with cabin air issues. A number of peer reviewed scientific studies have demonstrated that there is no increase in overall cancer or mortality rates among cabin and flight crew.
